his I wish to state in reply to your lette of 5th Neary 1899 No 6079 that There are us other Indian Reserves, To my Knew Loge, in Preton Historia Grant Reserves and the two islands in Meregenist Hearlow. The names Indian Cove is dominary wase now of as indicating the hart of Fraher's heart where the Indians reside. It is marked en the plant sent me as bloodie's Com To avaid mistakes or mismosmatanding, I will in future call the Reserves there, Frake's Er aut Reserves". The locality called Pine Free in my correspondence is at the Read of Mariganish Harlor, and in this place at a paint lordering on the Larbor, reside or have squatted six or more families of Sudians. Both these Indians and one of the proprectors of the land on mulich they + quatted had asked me To present their case to the Deft. with the rein of huchasing said laws for them. See letters dated Ottana 12th april 1889 No 6079. Ottana 12th May 1892 No 6079. My reasons for stating that I thought it mould be to their advantage to have their Reserves in one black, than to have it in small Reserver, in different houts of the County, was that if the Dept. decided upon hurchasing in me land for them, it would be better to have it purchases adjoining their Peacons at Fisher's Evant I would not house rather than at Pine hee.
