SIR:-

The Department is sending to you under separate cover the pay-lists of the distribution of interest money for 1914 to Indians of St. Peter's Band, in order that they may be completed. In every case where the number in a family has increased or decreased, full explanation should be furnished in the "Remarks" column of the pay-lists, except when the increase or decrease is due to a birth or death, which change is self-explanatory and should be noted in the column provided for the purpose. If an individual who has been known by a certain number is paid under another number, the change should be explained.

example:- At the previous distribution three shares were paid under No. 8. At the last distribution only one share was paid under No. 8, which necessitates an explanation with regard to the decrease of two under this number. There is a decrease of one by death, but the other decrease is not explained. If the third person is living, you should give the band and number under which the said person is paid. Kindly furnish the necessary information in both the original and duplicate pay-lists, and in future you should be particular to furnish all necessary information in connection with payments made.
