(a) A-116681 Spr. Barrick, P.E. - RCE (1 CERU) having been sentenced by a District Court Martial at Petawawa Military Camp on 24 Oct 44 to undergo detention for 128 days, the O.A., Petawawa Military Camp has remitted the balance of detention from and after the 1st day of February, 1945.
