

Langley Indian Reserve

Fort Langley, B. C.

May 10th 1946.

We, the undersigned, members of the Langley Band of Indians owning the Reserve situated at Fort Langley, B. C. in the New Westminster Indian Agency, in the province of British Columbia at a meeting summoned for the purpose, according to the rules of the Band, and held on the said Reserve, this 10th day of May, A.D. 1946, in the presence of the Indian Agent, representing thereat the Minister of Mines and Resources for the Dominion of Canada;

Do hereby for ourselves, and on behalf of the Indians of the said reserve, request that a sum not exceeding Four Thousand Dollars, be paid out of money standing to the credit of this Band, for the purpose of purchasing a Farmall Tractor and equipment (\$2000), for the purpose of road repair (\$1500), for the purpose of providing four wells for the village (\$400), and the purpose of a new house for one member and repair to the house of another (\$600).
