647. What churches were formed on Paul's second missionary journey?

On Paul's second missionary journey, he formed the churches of Philippi, Thessalonica and Corinth.

652. How did Paul escape from the wicked plot made against him in Jerusalem?

Paul's nephew told the Roman captain of the plot, who immediately sent Paul under a guard of soldiers, to Cæsarea.

653. Before what noted persons did Paul preach when he was a prisoner in Cæsarea?

When Paul was a prisoner in Cæsarea, he preached before the Roman governors, Felix and Festus, and King Agrippa.
