Explantions of the Calendar Pages.

At the head of the respective pages for each month are given the ordinary tables of the changes and quadratures of the Moon. The 1st and 2d columns show the mean times of the rising and setting of the Sun. The quantities are only set down to the nearest minute, the uncertainty of the observed times of the rising or setting of heavenly bodies on land, caused by the varying amount of horizontal refraction and the general liability to the intervention of terrestial objects in such observations, renders a closer approximation unnecessary for ordinary practical purposes. In the 3rd columns, marked "south," are given the times which should be shown by a well regulated clock or watch when the Sun is on the Meridian. The 4th column shows the moon's place. The 5th column contains the mean times of the rising or setting of the Moon. The quantities are only set down to the nearest minute, for the reasons mentioned above in respect to the Sun.
