POWER DEVELOPMENT IN QUEBEC.

QUEBEC.

The Quebec Railway Light and Power Company, finding the power at Montmorency Falls inadequate at certain seasons, have undertaken the construction of a huge reservoir about half a mile higher up the river to provide an ample supply of water all the year round. The company have erected there, according to the plans of Mr. E. A. Evans, chief engineer and general manager, a dam 84 ft. high the highest in Canada, for such a purpose. It is 67 feet 4 inches wide at the base and 12 feet wide at the crest, and will hold back 52,000,000 cubic feet of water. The contract for the plant to develop this power has been awarded to Allis-Chalmers-Bullock, Limited, Montreal, the only firm in Canada who build both the electrical and the mechanical portions of a hydro-electric development. It will consist of a 1,500 k.w. alternating current generator, driven by a 2,225 h p. turbine water wheel.
