Advances made on consignments of Produce. instead of the latter part of November, as has hitherto been the case. 5133 Policies were issued between the 23rd November, 1866, and the 31st December, 1867, covering \$3,570,203. shewing an excess of 1,312 policies over that of the previous year. The total amount of risk is now \$8,716,423.54, represented by 12,708 policies, averaging \$685.90 each policy. **Losses**. The losses during the period between the 23rd November, 1866, and the 31st December, 1867, for which the Company were liable, reache 1 \$18,447.08, representing 58 claims, 16 R. C. Hamilton & Co. Of these claims, 54 had been paid prior to closing the books, while the remaining 4, then under investigation, have since been paid. There were also four claims which were, after mature consideration, rejected, the Directors being of opinion that they were neither legally nor morally bound to entertain them.
