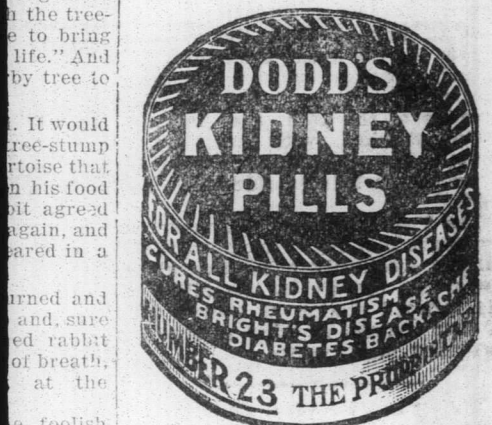

Rome, Aug. 17.—The chief damage resulting from the earthquake which shook dozens of cities and towns in Central Italy yesterday morning was at Rimini, where four persons are dead and thirty injured.

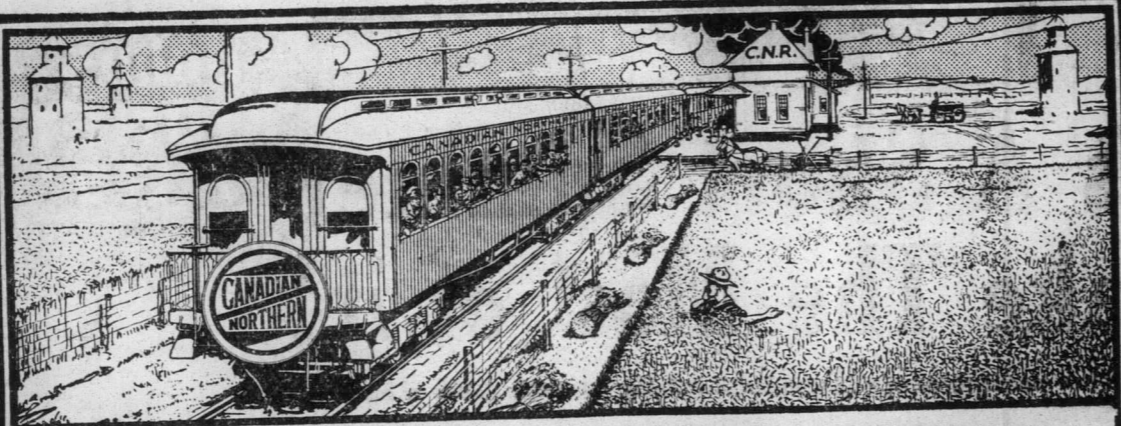
The military and civil authorities are caring for the injured and homeless. The earthquake caused a panic among the population of many of the central cities and villages.
