In order that the spread fof the
disease may be checkcd, it is neces-
gary that great care be taken to
avold the conveyance of the virus
from the diseased to healthy Where practicable, it is well to re
move all non-infectel move all non-infectel animals to non-
intected premises. It this cannot be
done, the discased animals should be isolated, and the premises in which
they had been kept slould be dis infected by thoroughly sweepins and
dusting, and then giving a thorough
coat of an thee side. per cent. of one of the coal tar anti-
septics or carbolic acid, or a coat ol bolic acid. This precaution is desir-
able on account of the virus lodging other animais.
