Latest Quotations Which are of Interest to Everybody.

Retail Prices in Chatham—Gossip About Grain.

Planet Office, Wednesday evening, Jan. 24.

J. B. Stringer & Co. give the following gossip:

Wheat—The market is a little brighter. The Chicago market has been better for the last few days. Some of the bears are evidently turning into buyers.

Beans—Market quiet after the rush of the past fortnight. Stocks not being large the market is holding firm at last week's advanced prices. Receipts from farmers are light.

Coarse Grains—Oats, barley and buckwheat are in light supply but fair demand at the prices quoted.

Dressed Hogs—The market is acting better and dealers' bids are up from 10 to 15 cents per cwt. The price now being paid is from \$4.25 to \$4.50, but \$5 pork is looked for.

Barley, 75 to 75c. cwt. Corn, new, shelled, 31c.

Beans, \$1.20 to \$1.30. Buckwheat, 50c.

HOUSEKEEPERS' PRICES. There was a good showing of vegetables and fruits on the market on Wednesday. Prices, however, show no change. Apples were fairly plentiful at from 20 to 25c. There was a small amount of dressed pork offered at 5 to 6c, according to quarter.

In the shed there was a small offering of dressed fowl. Chickens were high at from 20 to 30 cents and ducks sold at from 25 to 30c. The offering of butter and eggs was almost nil, and there was not sufficient to base quotations on.

TORONTO DRESSED HOGS. Toronto, Jan. 24.—Deliveries of dressed hogs not free, and market fairly firm. The demand for provisions is steady, and values steady. Select weights, dressed hogs, car lots, on track, delivered, sell at \$5.25 to \$5.30, and at \$5 to \$5.15 for heavy, and mixed lots; sows are 50c to \$1 off these prices. On the street, in farm-

ers' loads, choice bring from \$5.30 to \$5.40, according to quality.

THOMAS WANLESS DEAD.

He Had Been Connected With the Opera House For Many Years.

Thomas Wanless, one of the best known residents in the city, passed away last evening in his 30th year. Mr. Wanless had been suffering for two years from diabetes but, although in poor health, was able to work at his vocation almost to the time of his death. He was employed for 14 years as ticket-taker for the pit of the opera house and was in his accustomed place last Saturday evening. Sunday he was also able to be around but Monday had a more than usually severe attack of the malady from which he suffered. Tuesday night he lapsed into unconsciousness from which he never recovered until he passed away last evening at 10.15 o'clock.

Thomas Wanless, youngest son of the late T. K. Wanless, was born in this city in 1863 and has resided here all his life. Some twenty years ago he learned the trade of carpenter with the late John F. Heath. Mr. Wanless was well noted for his industry and activity. His good nature and hearty recognition of everyone endeared him to all who knew him, both rich and poor. For a number of years he served on the school board and made an excellent trustee. He married the daughter of the late Francis Maine, Miss P. A. Maine, who with two children, May and Ida, survive him.

Henry Wanless, of Bay City, John C. and George J., of this city, are brothers.

Mr. Wanless carried \$2,000 insurance in the A.O.U.W. and was also a member of the A. O. F. Mr. Wanless was Past Chief Ranger of Court Hope, No. 3,744, A. O. F. The funeral will take place Sunday afternoon at 2 o'clock from the family residence, Laurier street, to Maple Leaf cemetery.
