FISHES TRAVELLING BY LAND.

Dr. Hancock, in the Zoological Journal, gives a description of a fish called the flathead hassar, that travels to pools of water when that in which it resides dries up. Boss also describes another variety which is found in South Carolina, and, if our memory serves us well, also in Texas, which, like the flathead, leaves the drying pools in search of other waters. These fishes, filled with water, travel by night, on a lizard-like motion, and the other by leaps. The South Carolina and Texas varieties are furnished with a membrane over the mouth, by which they are enabled to carry with them a supply of water to keep their gills moist during their travel. These fishes, guided by some peculiar instinct, always travel in a straight line to the nearest water. This they do without the aid of memory, for it has been found that if a tub filled with water is sunk in the ground near one of these pools which they inhabit, they will when the pool dries up, move directly toward the tub.

CHICKEN SNAKE.

A peculiar kind of a reptile, known as the "chicken snake," exists in the Sacramento valley, and, perhaps, throughout other portions of the State. They are found in the oak and other trees, for the purpose of catching the young birds, which are to be found in their nests among the branches. A few evenings since, a little girl, living on a ranch in the neighbourhood of the city, went in the dusk of the evening to a chicken coop, which was placed on the ground, for the purpose of attending to the juveniles which were hatched in the coop. She had placed under her charge, when she unconsciously laid her hand on one of these snakes, which was almost two feet in length. It had coiled itself around one of the brood, while the others were clustering closely around it. The snake was so cold, but not until the life of the chicken was extinct. It may be that these reptiles are well known to ranchmen throughout the State, but we do not remember to have ever seen a description of them.

THE FECUNDITY OF FLIES.

The flies have again become numerous and troublesome. The streets and houses abound with them. The ingenuity of man has not yet invented agents that can destroy them as fast as they come. There is to be wondered at, when it is known that from a single fly more than two millions of these pests are produced in one summer.

Clay will permanently improve any soil that is sandy or leachy. Lime and leached ashes will benefit leachy land.

A tin of dry forest leaves produces only 500 pounds of mould; hence 500 pounds of mould will produce a ton of plants.

Clay applied to sandy land is far better than the sand to clay. Lead 100 tons to the acre will give 1 inch in depth.
