Vortes or TRANKS.—The silly practice of voting thanks to retiring public officials, no matter what may have been the character of their services, received a severe blow the other day on the retirement of the outgoing Lord Mayor of London. The customary vote of thanks was proposed by a member of the Common Council in a very unusual manner. Instead of enumerating the merits of the outgoing mayor, he paraded a long catalogue of his sins, and then proposed a vote of thanks in spite of them. The mayor, it was asserted, had been guilty of discourtesy, of "political idiosyncrasies," of "beggrafy hospitality," had snobbishly refused to preside at a public charitable dinner because the tiekets were too cheap, and committed many other offences of a similar character. On the whole, the repiring mayor, must have had a very unpleasant time listening to the coundiman's speech, and can hardly have felt compensated by getting his vote of thanks by a small majority. If this is to be the order of thanks will probably soon be at a discourt.
