London, May 30 .- The Scottish Home Rule bill passed its second reading in the house today, and was then referred to committee. It follows somewhat the lines of the Irish Home Rule bill, and was introduced by Wm. Henry Cowen, the member from East Aberdeenshire. Now that Ireland is in a fair way to receive self government, the unofficial Scottish Liberal members have taken Scottish Liberal members have taken up more seriously the question of securing home rule for their country. Additional Powers Given. The powers given by the bill to the Scottish parliament include all those conferred on the Irish parliament, but with the addition of the administration

The executive, however, it is proposed, shall continue vested in the King, who is to be represented in Scotland by a Lord High Commissioner, advised by the members of a Privy Council.
