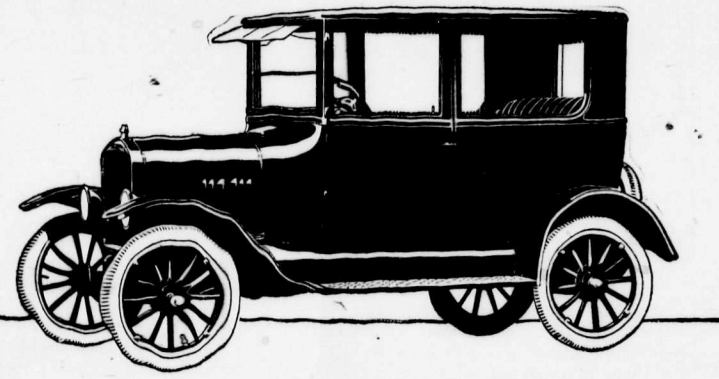

# BUY IN AYLMEER !

**To The Electors of Town of Aylmer**

The following is a synopsis of the By-Law of the Corporation of the Town of Aylmer, to the effect of the guarantee by the sale of the bonds of the A. BRANDON MANUFACTURING COMPANY LIMITED, to the amount of \$25,000.00.

TAKE NOTICE that the Corporation of the Town of Aylmer is submitting for the consideration of the electors entitled to vote at the Town Meeting on the 1st day of May, 1924, a By-Law No. 989 for the purpose of authorizing the Corporation to guarantee the bonds of the A. BRANDON MANUFACTURING COMPANY LIMITED, to the amount of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars, which bonds are payable in equal annual instalments on the 1st day of June in each of the years 1924 inclusive, with interest at the rate of six per cent, per annum, payable half-yearly on the 1st day of June and December in each year.

The reason and object of the guarantee is the purchase by the A. Brandon Manufacturing Company Limited, of the lands, buildings and equipment of what is known as the Shoe Factory Building in the Town of Aylmer, and the establishment and carrying on by the A. Brandon Manufacturing Company Limited, of a shoe factory on the premises of the said building for the term of fifteen years.

The Corporation of the Town of Aylmer in giving the said guarantee to be secured by a first mortgage on the lands, buildings, plant and equipment of the A. Brandon Manufacturing Company Limited, and is to be further secured by a life insurance policy on the life of Alexander Brandon and James Brandon for the sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars, on the terms and conditions set forth in the plan, payable in fifteen years.

The following is a copy of the By-Law as amended and entered into between the Corporation of the Town of Aylmer and the A. Brandon Manufacturing Company Limited:

THIS AGREEMENT made this 17th day of March, 1924, between the Corporation of the Town of Aylmer, on the one part, and the A. Brandon Manufacturing Company Limited, on the other part, do hereby agree that the Corporation of the Town of Aylmer shall guarantee the bonds of the A. Brandon Manufacturing Company Limited, to the amount of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars, on the terms and conditions set forth in the plan, payable in fifteen years.
