JUDGMENT FOR PLAINTIFFS

Trust Company Ordered to Surrender Estate of Sir Adam Wilson.

Toronto, Oct. 11.—Mr. Justice Clute handed out judgment this morning in the action brought by Florence Dalton and David T. Symonds to compel the Toronto General Trusts Corporation and Mrs. E. M. Lilley Wilson to hand over the estate of the late Emma Wilson, widow of the late Sir Adam Wilson, of which they are the executors and trustees. The judgment was in favor of the plaintiffs, and the trust company was ordered to give up the estate.
