ATMOSPHERE IS SO HEAVY OLD LAKE HURON SHRINKS

Water Near Sarnia Drops Two
Feet Six Inches in
Hour.

THEN IT RETURNS

Special to The Advertiser.
Sarnia, July 9.—At noon today the
water in Lake Huron fell rapidly.
Lakeside residents reported. At vari-
ous places 25 feet of additional beach
was visible. The gauge at the
Gratiot lighthouse showed the maxi-
mum drop to be 2½ feet. The tide
returned before evening.

The falling water is an incident
that is liable to happen at any time.
It is caused by atmospheric pressure,
and not entirely by wind, experts say.
In the first place, it is commonly
said that rapid variance in lake levels
takes place when the wind which
at first blew one way, becomes re-
versed and pushes the water rapidly
away from the point where it had
accumulated it before. The change
today was caused by the rapidity
with which the barometer fell.

The air was fast becoming moist
and heavy at noon, and the increased
weight at this end of the lake bore
down the water, which raised it cor-
respondingly in some other part of
the lake where the air is and does
not weigh so much. As the air over
all the lake becomes damp and the
pressure becomes more equal, the
water will swing back to normal.

NINE VACANCIES IN UPPER HOUSE

Death of Senator De Veber
Suggests Possibility of Ap-
pointment of Oliver.

Ottawa, July 9.—With the death of
Senator De Veber, the number of
vacancies in the upper house is now
brought up to nine. There are two
vacancies for Ontario, two for Que-
bec, one for New Brunswick, two for
Prince Edward Island and two for
Alberta.

So unusually large a number of
Senate vacancies unfilled, particu-
larly on the eve of a probable cabinet
reorganization, is giving rise to wide-
spread speculation. Candidates or
possible candidates for Senate vacan-
cies have been mentioned almost by
the dozen.

The death of Senator De Veber
suggests the possibility, according to
one rumor, that Hon. Frank Oliver
may now be appointed to one of the
Alberta vacancies and his seat on
the railway board filled by Judge
Turgeon of Saskatchewan.

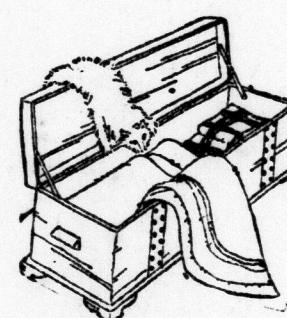
