### TOLL OF DEATH MAY REACH SIX HUNDRED

Six Villages Completely Isolated by Floods as Result of Earthquake

Batavia, Java, Nov. 15.—The death toll in the earthquake which shook the central portion of the island of Java last Wednesday is estimated in official circles at 300, although private reports indicate that as many as 600 persons may have perished.

Six villages are completely isolated by floods. The damage to private property at Wonorebo exceeds \$120,000.

The earth is still trembling from slight shocks. It is generally accepted here that the earthquake was not of a volcanic nature but merely due to the shifting of earth layers.

### COMING BACK TO NEW BRUNSWICK

Montreal Despatch to Fredericton Gleaner Says Baxter Failed at Ottawa

Montreal, Nov. 15.—Hon. J. B. M. Baxter's days in Federal politics are numbered, according to apparently well authenticated reports which are going the rounds of political circles. The certainty is that before the next general elections he will be back in provincial politics in New Brunswick again as leader of the Conservative Opposition party in that Province.

While Mr. Baxter's return to provincial politics in New Brunswick will be camouflaged to make it appear that he is being "called," the facts are that his exit from the Federal field is the result of his failure to measure up to the required standard. He failed to broaden out when he got to Ottawa and, in addition to that, he is blamed for much of the intrigue against Rt. Hon. Arthur Meighen, the conservative leader.

In other words Mr. Baxter's so-called "Maritime Rights" campaign has raised so much trouble within the Conservative party, has operated so strongly against the possibility of success of the party and has proven such an obstacle towards consolidating the Federal party that Mr. Baxter has simply got to go. And the programme is for him to go back to provincial politics.

I help to make this evening hour; I record the great and the small, the varied acts of the days and weeks that go to make up life.

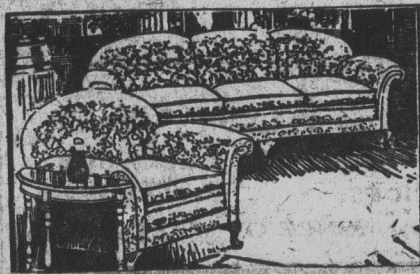
I am for and of the home; I follow those who leave the humble beginnings whether they go to greatness or to the gutter, I take to them the thrill of old days, with wholesome messages.

I am the word of the week, the history of the year, the record of my community, in the archives of community and nation.

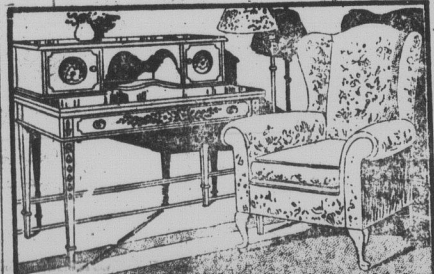
