

4. To prosecute every kind of scientific study comprehended in Geographical Science and which may enlarge our knowledge of the Earth we inhabit, and the forms, structure, and relations of terrestrial objects and agencies.

5. To open communication with the Geographical Societies of other countries, in order to profit by their researches and their labours, and to secure their co-operation in our work.

6. To publish Transactions annually or semi-annually, containing extracts of the minutes of proceedings at meetings, records of the work performed, papers, correspondence, &c., which may be deemed worthy of publication.

7. To form a library consisting principally of geographical works and charts.

ARTICLE III.

The Geographical Society of Quebec shall consist of an indeterminate number of Members, divided into Associate Members, Corresponding Members, and Honorary Members.

ARTICLE IV.

The associate members can be elected only at the ordinary meetings of the Society. They must have been previously proposed in writing at an ordinary meeting, by two associate members. The election shall be by ballot, and it shall be necessary that at least two thirds of the votes of the members present shall have been given in favor of a candidate, in order to his being elected.

ARTICLE V.

There shall be no voting for the admission of a member, unless one of the associate members who have proposed the candidate be present to move that the ballot be proceeded with.
