It was possible to do this because the United Kingdom is the main source and arrangements were made with the authorities controlling exports from the United Kingdom whereby only the types required by Canada were permitted to be exported against the Canadian allocation. General permits were issued also to allow immediate unrestricted entry of some goods pending procurement of an Order in Council removing the goods from the controlled list.
