

AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF  
THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO FOR THE TRAINING IN CANADA  
OF PERSONNEL OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND  
TOBAGO

The Government of Canada and the Government of the  
Republic of Trinidad and Tobago hereinafter referred to as  
Canada and Trinidad and Tobago respectively,

Considering that Trinidad and Tobago has requested  
Canada to provide training in Canada for personnel of the armed  
forces of Trinidad and Tobago,

Have agreed as follows:

ARTICLE 1

Definitions

In this Agreement

- (a) "trainee" means a member of the armed forces of Trinidad  
and Tobago who has been authorized by his government to  
undergo training in Canada with the Canadian Forces and  
who has been accepted by Canada for training;
- (b) "training" means the military training prescribed by the  
Chief of the Defence Staff of the Canadian Forces.

ARTICLE 2

Training and Costs

Subject to terms and conditions of this Agreement, Canada  
shall provide training in Canada for trainees in such numbers as
