

- (i) the port of entry and the place of residence of said personnel in Saint Lucia at the beginning of their assignment; and
 - (ii) the place of residence and the point of departure of said personnel in Saint Lucia upon completion of their assignment.
- (f) The cost of transportation of:
- (i) the personal and household effects of the Canadian personnel and those of their dependents; and
 - (ii) the professional and technical material required by said personnel in the execution of their duties in Saint Lucia,
between
 - (iii) the port of entry and the place of residence of said personnel in Saint Lucia at the beginning of their assignment; and
 - (iv) the place of residence and the point of departure of said personnel in Saint Lucia upon completion of their assignment.
- (g) Any official assistance which may be required for the purpose of facilitating the travel of Canadian personnel in the performance of their duties in Saint Lucia.
- (h) All off-loading and other handling costs at port of entry, and any official assistance which may be required for the purpose of expediting the clearance through customs of equipment, products, materials, supplies, and other goods required for the execution of projects and the personal and household effects of Canadian personnel and their dependents.
- (i) The storage of articles, mentioned in paragraph (h) above, during the period when they are held at customs, and any measures required to protect these articles against natural elements, theft, fire, and any other dangers.
- (j) The prompt inland transportation of all equipment, products, materials, supplies, and other imported goods required for the execution of projects, from the port of entry in Saint Lucia to project sites, including where necessary, the obtaining of priority service by forwarding and transportation agents.
- (k) The travel expenses and the cost of hotel or other suitable accommodation, including meals of the Canadian personnel, but not of their dependents, at a level corresponding to their status and rank while they are required to travel on duty.
