The Department of External Affairs announced today that His Excellency Dr. Mahmoud Fawzi, the Minister of Foreign Affairs of Egypt, will arrive in Ottawa on Tuesday afternoon, June 28 at Uplands Airport for a three-day visit to Ottawa. Dr. Fawzi has been attending the commemorative meetings in San Francisco of the tenth anniversary of the United Nations.

During his visit the Egyptian Foreign Affairs
Minister will call upon the Prime Minister of Canada, the
Right Honourable Louis S. St. Laurent; on the Minister of
Trade and Commerce and Defence Production, the Right
Honourable C.D. Howe; and on the Secretary of State for
External Affairs, Ma. L.B. Pearson. Dr. Fawzi will hold a
press conference in the large conference room of the East
Block at 10:20 a.m. Wednesday, June 29. On Thursday morning
he will leave Ottawa at 9:00 a.m. for the Atomic Energy of
Canada Limited plant at Chalk River.

His Excellency El Husseini El Khatib, the Ambassador of Egypt, will entertain late Thursday afternoon and Thursday evening at a reception and dinner at the Country Club. Mr. Pearson will be the host at a dinner in Dr. Fawzi's honour the previous evening.

During his stay in Ottawa, Dr. Fawzi will be at the Chateau Laurier. He will leave from Uplands Airport for New York on Friday, July 1.
