DIPLOMATIC APPOINTMENTS

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Honourable Mark MacGuigan, announces the following appointments:

William L. Clarke (37) originally from Rosetown, Saskatchewan, to be Consul General in Sao Paulo, Brazil.

Mr. Clarke (B.A., University of Saskatchewan) joined the Trade Commissioner Service in 1966. He has served abroad in The Hague, Singapore and Brasilia, and in Ottawa he served in the Trade Commissioner Service Personnel Administration (1975-77). Since 1978 he has been Consul and Senior Trade Commissioner in San Francisco. Mr. Clarke is replacing Mr. V.G. Lotto who is returning to Ottawa.

D. Martin Collacott (49) originally from Ottawa, to be High Commissioner to Sri Lanka, with concurrent accreditation to the Maldives.
