To Our Beloved and Faithful the Senators of Canada, and the Members elected to serve in the House of Commons of Canada, and to all whom it may concern,—

GREETING:

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS We have thought fit, by and with the advice and consent of Our Prime Minister of Canada, to DISSOLVE the present Parliament of Canada.

Now Know YE, that We do for that end publish this Our Royal Proclamation, and do hereby DISSOLVE the said Parliament of Canada accordingly; and the Senators and the Members of the House of Commons are discharged from their meeting and attendance.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent, and the Great Seal of Canada to be hereunto affixed. WITNESS: Our Trusty and Well-beloved Major-General George Philias Vanier, Companion of Our Distinguished Service Order upon whom We have conferred Our Military Cross and Our Canadian Forces' Decoration, Governor General and Commander-in-Chief of Canada.

At The Citadel, in Our City of Quebec, this nineteenth day of April in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-two and in the eleventh year of Our Reign.
