PSYCHOLOGICAL STUDIES REGARDING WOMEN IN COMBAT - RAISED BY MR. NOWLAN

Women have taken part in combat during periods of extreme national emergency, particularly Soviet women during WWII and Israeli women during the 1948 Arab/Israeli conflict. There is, however, no empirical data available on the psychological impact of women on the firing line and its effect on the capability of male soldiers.
