And on the motion of Mr. Stanfield, seconded by Mr. Wagner, in amendment thereto,—That the following words be added to the Address:

“We respectfully suggest to your Excellency that the failure of your Ministers to act resolutely after the election of July 8th, last, has contributed to the increasing disparity and the social and economic disarray in the country, which require prompt, decisive leadership which is lacking in the Speech from the Throne.”

And on the motion of Mr. Broadbent, seconded by Mr. Knowles (Winnipeg North Centre), in amendment to the said proposed amendment,—That the amendment be amended by changing the period at the end thereof to a comma, and by adding immediately thereafter the following words:

“and we regret in particular the failure of Your Excellency’s advisers to make immediate proposals to assist those who are hardest hit by inflation, and also their failure to take immediate steps to increase the production of necessary goods and services and thus reduce the unemployment that so seriously affects the lives of so many of our people.”

And debate continuing; at 9.37 o’clock p.m., Mr. Speaker interrupted the proceedings pursuant to Standing Order 38(3);
