2. At what places were they erected and what corporation, firm or person

is operating them, or are they operated by some government agency.

3. What did the said plants cost?

4. Has the government during that period advanced to any corporation, firm or individual, financial assistance for any such mechanical fish drying plants?

5. If so, how much has been advanced or paid out, and at what places

and to which corporations, firms or individuals?

6. Have any contracts been entered into by any department of the government with any corporation, firm or individual for the building of any such mechanical fish drying plants, and what proportion of the cost of same will be borne by the government?"
