Dear Sir:

Dr. Snell has informed me that you have expressed to him your approval of the appointment of an assistant in the English department here. In regard to the distribution of the cost of this appointment, it would seem just that since Household Science students take the same courses as students in Agriculture, and since their number is approximately the same, one half of such cost should be charged to the School of Household Science. I understand that the estimated amount is six hundred dollars which would add three hundred dollars to the budget suggestion submitted by me for your consideration at the time of our interview. You will recall that I mentioned to you at the time that up to the present we had not paid anything for the instruction in English given our Household Science students.
