## EVIDENCE ACT.

4. 2. The wife or husband of a person charged with an offence against any of the sections two hundred and two to two hundred and six inclusive, two hundred and eleven to two hundred and nineteen inclusive, two hundred and thirty-eight, two hundred and thirty-nine, two hundred and forty-two A, two hundred and forty-five, two hundred and ninety-eight to three hundred and two inclusive, three hundred and seven to three hundred and eleven inclusive, three hundred and thirteen to three hundred and eleven inclusive, three hundred and thirteen to three hundred and sixteen inclusive of the Criminal Code, shall be a competent and compellable witness for the prosecution without the consent of the person charged.
