This belief was confirmed by a letter received yesterday from Mr. Rennie, who, it is understood, declines returning to Canada to give evidence in the matter. mer, G. Cheney, J. S. McLachlan, A. Ewan, W. Denoon, J. K. Ward, and A. A. Ayer. The only preliminary arrangement of importance not yet completed is the selection of a site; numerous offers have been made, but the company experience some difficulty in deciding upon the one most advantageous. There is a strong desire for obvious reasons to locate the factory in the immediate vicinity of this city, provided similar accommodations to those offered elsewhere, in the shape of water-power, bonus, and freedom from taxes, &c., can be secured. The municipality of St. Hyacinthe have offered a bonus of at least \$25,000, and freedom from taxation, and it is understood that the Mayor of Three Rivers and other municipalities nearer home have offered similar inducements. The stockholders are all selected from among the staunchest business men of Montreal, and it is intended to erect a mill with a capacity for employing from 400 to 500 hands.
