

## P O S T S C R I P T.

**I**T may not be improper to make some Apology, to the Reader, for printing these Sheets, in the Absence of Captain *Williams*. They were wrote last Year, when that Gentleman was in *England*, and a Copy presented to the Right Honourable the Lords Commissioners of Trade and Plantations; also a few of them were distributed amongst his intimate Friends; when it was earnestly wished, that most valuable Branch of Trade would have been seriously considered in the House of Commons: and at a Time when the settling and securing of our Colonies, and Rights of Treaty (so grossly and scandalously abused, before the late War), ought to have been the grand Business of Administration: But, by the Instability of our People then employed, who have since undergone almost a total Change, those Copies may have been lost, or mis-laid.
