monkies, fquirrels, and a cock and hen, the latter of which they thot. According to Linnæus, this ifland is their native place on believe and poller (isod

Thursday the 27th, in the evening, our boats returned with more buffaloes, but much older than the others. The flesh of all was very course, without the least particle of fat.

On Friday the 28th, at noon, we took up our anchors and made fail: when out of the harbour we fhaped our coarse for the ftraits of Banca.

On the afternoon of Tuesday, February the ift, we passed Pulo-Timoan, and Pulo-Pisang; and at half pass nine in the evening were a-breast of Pulo-Aro. Thursday the 3d, at six in the morning, we saw the Seven-islands and Monopinhill, which are situated near the entrance into the straits, our soundings varying from sourceen to nineteen fathoms, decreasing and increasing alternately.
