of Church enterprises and of larger Christian usefulness. To meet these necessities the root of the matter must be touched, not by theories, but by organized Bible study.

On account of Particular Conditions.—By which individuals need to be considered who cannot attend the school; families may be isolated; parties may be travelling, or invalided, or recreating; neighborhoods may be remote and indifferent. Hence the need arises for the (1) individual Home Class member, (2) the Family Class, (3) the Correspondence Class, (4) the neighborhood Class.
