

*BY-LAW of the Municipal Council of the District of
Johnstown relating to the breach or violation of any By-
Law.*

The Council of the District of Johnstown duly assembled in Council in the Town of Brockville on Saturday the twelfth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty-two, in virtue of an Act passed in the fourth and fifth years of the Reign of Her Majesty Queen Victoria, entitled "*An Act to provide for the better internal government of that part of this Province which formerly constituted the Province of Upper Canada by the establishment of Local or Municipal Authorities therein,*" do ordain and enact the following By-Law, and it is hereby enacted, That for any breach or violation of any By-Law now enacted, or that may be hereafter enacted by this Council, the person convicted thereof shall suffer and pay a penalty, not more than Five Pounds nor less than Five Shillings in the discretion of the Court ordering the conviction, together with all reasonable costs incurred.
