New G. T. R. Time Table.

Wabash Passenger Service Will Be Via St. Thomas After May 15.

Railroad City Will Thereby Have Eight Additional Through Trains Daily—Fourteen Citizens Transferred—Added Service for Londoners.

With the introduction of the new time table on the G. T. R., May 15, the Wabash passenger train service will be transferred to the Air Line, so that after that date no Wabash trains will run through London. St. Thomas will have eight additional through trains daily—four each way. This means that the service will be doubled, and the population of the Railroad City will be increased by twice the number of passengers. The present there are but four Wabash trains, two each way, running through London, and as a result of the change fourteen Londoners—conductors, engineers and firemen—will transfer their place of residence to St. Thomas. The loss in the up, however, will be made up by the fact that the train service on local men will be advanced and among some firemen brought in from outside.

A new train to be put on here will leave for Windsor on the arrival of the Lehigh Express. The new train from Windsor, making the run in 2 hours and 40 minutes.

The new train from Chicago, via Port Huron, will arrive here about 4:40 p.m.

The Buffalo train, leaving at 7 o'clock, will connect with the Lehigh Express at Paris for the west.

It is understood that the new time table will contain no changes of moment on the branch lines.

Manager Hays, General Superintendent, and Mr. Morris and Trainmaster Cunningham passed through St. Thomas yesterday in a special train. Officials had come from Detroit, and after going over the southern division the manager returned to London last night. A large force of men are at work putting in new steel rails on the southern division, and the work will last for some time, as about 50 miles of track has to be relaid.

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
