#### VETERANS ENTITLED TO AID EXAMINATIONS FREE MEDICAL SERVICE

Not Necessary to Spend Money Doctors' Bills.

F. S. Fisher, unit service officer of "F" Unit of the D. S. C. R., said yesterday that a large number of returned men in the district were paying out considerable money for medical treat ment unnecessarily, and that they given out as soon as the returns are were overlooking the fact that returned men were entitled to free medical treatment for a period of twelve months from the date of their discharge. They could secure such treatment by applying to the medical

branch of the D. S. C. R.

The assistance was provided for by the Government, which realized that many men might be subject to sickness or a recurrence of war wounds from time to time after discharge. Mr. Fisher pointed out that blame could not be attached to the doctors, for there was no law compelling them to tell a returned man that he was entitled to free treatment.
