EMPRESS' ROUGH TRIP.

Arrives at Halifax Escorted in Ice—Col. Swayne a Passenger.

HALIFAX, N.S., Dec. 3.—(Special.)—The C. P. R. liner Empress of Ireland arrived in port this afternoon from Liverpool, after a very rough voyage. The ropes and cables around the steamers' decks were encased in ice.

Among the passengers was, Colonel Swayne, governor of British Honduras, who is returning after a visit to England. Col. Swayne has been requested by the imperial government to visit British Columbia and investigate the grievances regarding Asiatic immigration.

It will be remembered that Col. Swayne commanded the expedition in 1904 to Somaliland several years ago, in pursuit of the Mad Mahdians.

NEED FAITH TO AROUSE VALLEY OF DEAD BONES

Rev. A. C. Dixon, Chicago, gave a clear and forceful address last night at the fifth annual meeting of the "Regions Beyond" Missionary Union, held in Massey Hall last night. The attendance was large. J. K. Macdonald, president, said:

"The Union has over 100 missionaries in various foreign fields."

Rev. Dr. Robert Johnson, Montreal, said that the Presbyterian general assembly once looked askance at foreign missions. The church had since realized that its business was to give the bread of life to the hungry world. It was but 100 years since the first missionaries went out to India. Now India has a Christian church three hundred thousand strong. The missionary history was one of glorious triumph.

Secret of Success.

Rev. Dr. A. C. Dixon, Chicago, said he liked the religion of the illiterate slave, who asked to be taught to spell Jesus first because all the rest would be easy. That was the secret of missionary success. The successful missionaries were owned by and possessed of God. He liked men who saw visions. The young men who never built castles in the air never built any on the ground. The vision of the great work to be done in South America was a glorious one. It was the next step in missionary effort.
