EXHIBITION SURPLUS FELL OFF NEARLY \$10,000

Increase in Expenses More Than Offset \$15,000 Gain in Receipts.

The result of the audit by City Solicitor Sterling of the accounts of the Canadian National Exhibition, as presented to the board of control yesterday, are not as satisfactory as had been hoped. Not only is there a falling off in net profits, but the cheque payable to the city, after settling aside expenses, the usual custom, is a little over \$12,000 less than the estimated profits.

The decrease is due to the fact that, while gross receipts increased about 65 per cent, expenses increased about 134 per cent. The figures are: Receipts, 1909... \$249,603.16
Receipts, 1908... \$234,157.31

Increase over 1908... \$15,465.00
Expenses, 1909... \$211,643.84
Expenses, 1908... \$186,551.31

Increase over 1908... \$25,092.53
The increased expenditure is due chiefly to fireworks and special attractions which cost \$5,209.70 more in 1909, while other increases were: Military and bands, \$2,469.25; manufacturing processes, \$1,206.71; and repairs and maintenance, \$4,670.47.

Mr. Sterling points out that the value of the exhibition is not to be judged by the amount it contributes to the treasury, but the far larger indirect benefit reaped by the citizens. The exhibition is the best of the excellent condition of the books and vouchers.

Widening Gore Vale Avenue. The court of revision yesterday heard the arguments of residents of the upper portion of Gore Vale Ave. against being assessed for widening the lower portion of the thoroughfare by the inclusion of a two-foot strip, to give a uniform width of 50 feet. The matter was laid over.
