TREASURER.—The Treasurer shall keep a proper record of the finances, deposit in a bank, to be selected by the Board, to the credit of the Society, all moneys belonging to it coming into his hands, make all cheques for the payments of the Society, furnish at each quarterly meeting of the Board an abstract statement of account, and render a full and detailed account at the end of the financial year.

SECRETARY.—The Secretary shall keep a record of all the meetings of the Society, conduct the correspondence, and generally perform such other acts as may at any time be ordered by the Board.

VII. The Board shall make arrangements for soliciting subscriptions and donations from the inhabitants of St. John, and they shall establish proper agents and correspondents in different parts within the limits of the Auxiliary Society.

VIII. The subscriptions and donations received by the Society shall be applied, after deducting incidental expenses, to the purchase of such a number of Bibles and Testaments from the parent institution as are required for local supplies, to the support of Bible women or colporteurs; and the surplus funds shall be given to the Parent Society as a free contribution.

IX. For the purpose of giving full effect to the benevolent designs of the British and Foreign Bible Society in their grant of the Scriptures for distribution among the poor, the Board shall make it their business to enquire what families or individuals are in want of Bibles and Testaments, and unable to procure them, and it shall be the duty of the Board to furnish them therewith at prime cost, reduced price or gratis, according to circumstances.

X. For the still further promotion of the circulation of the Scriptures, it is expedient to encourage the formation of Branch Societies within the sphere of the Auxiliary Society, such Branch Societies to be entitled to the same privileges from the Auxiliary Society as it enjoys from the parent institution.

XI. No change shall be made in these Bye-laws except at a general meeting of the Society, notice of the proposed alteration having been given at the previous quarterly meeting of the Board.
