the General Committee, the Executive Committee and the Local Branches:

1st. The minute of the previous meeting to be read, approved and signed by the presiding officer and secretary.

2nd. Communications to be announced and read if required.

3rd. Reports of committees to be submitted.

4th. Unfinished business of previous meeting to be taken up.

5th. New business to be proceeded with. 6th. Proposal and election of members.

All decisions of the chair on points of order shall be conclusive, unless reversed on appeal to the meeting.

Every motion shall be first stated by the presiding officer before debate or taking a vote. Every motion shall be reduced to writing.

9. All annual subscribers to the fund of Queen's University

are to be deemed members of this Association.

10. Additions or amendments to the By-Laws shall be submitted in writing, proposed and seconded at a meeting of the General Committee; the same shall then be printed and sent to each member of the Committee with a notice that it shall be considered at the next regular meeting thereafter. Two thirds of all the votes cast shall be necessary for the adoption of the change proposed.
