CONSTITUTION.

ARTICLE 1.—This Society shall be called "THE WOMAN'S FOREIG MISSIONARY SOCIETY OF THE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH IN CANADA (Western Section), and its central point of operations shall be the Cit of Toronto.

ARTICLE 2.—Its object shall be to aid the Foreign Missionary Con mittee or Board of Missions, by promoting its work among the wome and children of heathen lands, and for this purpose it shall receive an disburse all money which shall be contributed to the Society, subject to the action of that Committee or Board, in the appointment of Missionaries supported by the Society, and fixing their salaries and location For the furtherance of this end it shall endeavour to organize similar associations throughout the Church, and these associations shall be the name of Auxiliary Societies to the Woman's Foreign Missionar Society of the Presbyterian Church in Canada, and shall report the work to this Society at such times as the By-laws may direct.

ARTICLE 3.—Each person paying one dollar annually, through a Auxiliary, or direct to the treasury, shall become a member of th Society. The payment of twenty-five dollars, by one person, at or time, shall constitute a life membership.

ARTICLE 4.—The business of the Society shall be conducted by Board of thirty-six managers, including the President four Vic Presidents, a Recording-Secretary, two Corresponding-Secretaries, an a Treasurer. They shall be elected from the members of the Societ annually, by the members who are present at the Annual Meeting They shall have power to elect non-resident Vice-Presidents, and appoint corresponding members when the objects of the Society shabe promoted thereby; they shall also have authority to fill vacanci occurring in their body during the year.

ARTICLE 5.—There shall be an Executive Committee composed the officers, and four other managers, to be elected annually. The
