### ENGLISH SIDELIGHTS

(New York Post.)

Bishop Weldon, writing to the London Times in reference to the recent letter of Lord Buckmaster on the anomalies of the English divorce laws, says: "The evidence of distinguished theologians shows how wide is the room for diversity of opinion, both as to the significance of our Lord's words respecting marriage and as to the application of His words to the circumstances of modern society. For the present it will be enough to say, in support of Lord Buckmaster's letter, that the church will not, I think, command the general assent of the enlightened Christian conscience if it imposes the same life long penalty of disability upon persons who, in the matrimonial relation, have proved themselves to be utterly culpable, and also upon other persons who, so far as any admissible evidence tells, must be held to be altogether innocent."

Writing on the same subject, Gen. Bramwell Booth of the Salvation Army says: "May I again urge that, having regard to the uncertainty of the traditional view and the undoubted variance in the record of our Lord's words, it might prove of the greatest value to the church if a small body of Christian men comprising the best authorities available should be asked to make a thorough investigation of the following questions: (1) What is the right expression of Christian principle in the actual circumstances of the day? (2) Are two views of our Lord's teaching respectively permissible? (3) If so, would not the churches do well to allow for both? (4) And cannot different parts of the church, as, e.g., in different countries,
