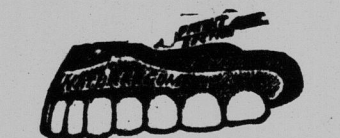
Allan French and Ambrose Pelke were witnesses at the elevator enquiry yesterday afternoon. The hearing was adjourned until Friday morning.
