MORE FARMERS. It is stated on good authority that only four men out of every hundred who start in business succeed.

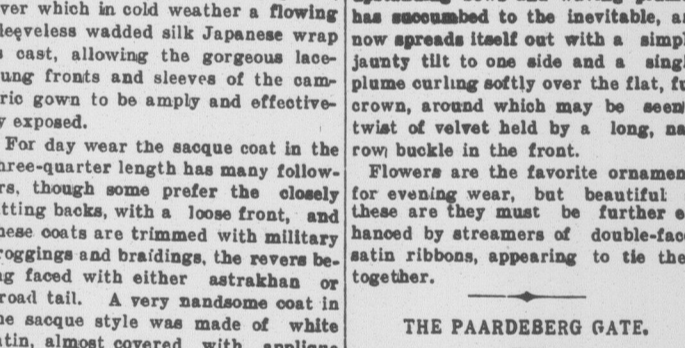
NOT CLIPPED. A naturalist says that the squirrel tribe is increasing all over the wooded districts of England, and in the Scottish Lowlands.

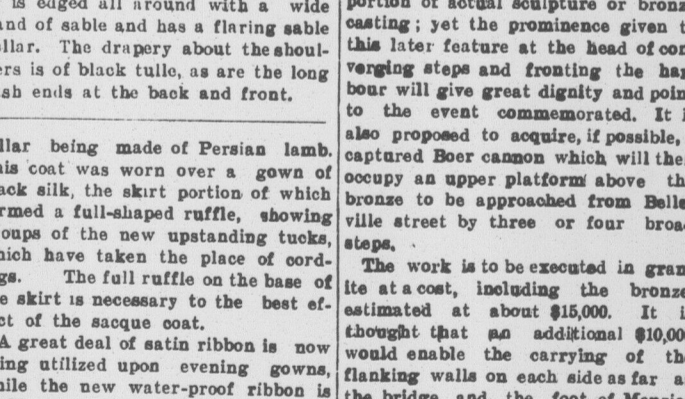
Fashion Review. The consciousness of being well dressed perhaps soothes to dream the women who have adopted the elaborate night dresses, which are now crowding out the simpler modes.
