MORE ARMENIANS ASSASSINATED.

Two of Them Shot Down in a London Street Wednesday.

SUICIDE FOLLOWS.

The Unknown Murderer, on Seeing Escape Hopeless, Drew a Revolver and Flew His Brains Out—The Police Mystified by the Tragic Events.

London, Nov. 4.—The dramatic murder of Sagat Sagouni, president of the Armenian Revolutionary Society, in London, on the night of October 23, was followed this afternoon by the assassination of two more delegates to the Armenian convention here. The suicide of the assassin, though he has not yet been identified, gives good reason to believe that he also was the slayer of Sagouni.


