


With Conditions Ideal, 55th at Sussex, Calls for Recruits

The officers mess together in the permanent rooms which formerly were part of the farm buildings. The sergeants have a separate mess at the other end of the camp, while each of the four companies has its own cookhouse equipped with two or three field ranges. Rations are good, and the men are well fed.
