WEDDERBURN MAKES A SHOW OF HARRY COLD Brook Rolling Mills Compa Perpetual World's Fair, Of the Dominion of Canada, which will prove of vast benefit to the whole contry.

For this purpose, the Legislature of the Stat of New York has granted a charter to a numbe of our most wealthy and respectable merchants, and those gentlemen have purchased no less than eight blocks of the most valuable land in the city of New York. 
