

Colonel 2nd Batt. Chicoutimi Militia. Sat for Chicoutimi and Tadousac in Leg. Assembly. Can from 1855 to g. e. 1857, and for Chicoutimi and Saguenay, from latter date until elected to Leg. Council for Laurentides division in 1864, where he sat until the Union. Called to the Senate by Royal Proclamation, May 1867.—*Wolfesfield, Quebec, Chicoutimi, P. Q.*

REESOR, *Hon. David, J. P. L.*

Of German descent. B. in Tp. of Markam, Ont. Ed. there. M. Emily, eldest dau. of Daniel McDougall, Esq., of St. Mary's, Ont., and sister of the Minister of Public Works. Founded the Markham *Economist* newspaper, of which he is editor. Has been Warden of York and Peel. Represented King's Division in Leg. Council, Can., from 1860 until the Union. Called to the Senate by Royal Proclamation, May 1867.—*Markham, Ont.*

RITCHIE, *Hon. John W., Q. C. C.*

Called to the Bar, N. S., Jan. 1832. Is a Gov. of Dalhousie College, Halifax, President of the Nova Scotia Barristers Society, and a director of the Union Bank of Halifax. Was Solicitor General, N. S., from 1864, until the Union. Was a delegate to the London B. N. A. Colonial Conference, 1866-7. Sat in Leg. Council, N. S., until called to the Senate, May, 1867.—*Halifax, N. S.*
