An Act to incorporate the Society salled La Caisse de Bienfaisance de Tempérance, section St. Jacques.

WHEREAS an association under the name of "La caisse de Bienfaisance de Tempérance, section St. Jacques," has existed for several years, in the City of Montreal, having for its object the aid of its members in case of sickness, and the ensuring of like assistance, 5 and other advantages to the widows and children of deceased members; And whereas the members of the said association have prayed to be incorporated, and it is expedient to grant their petition; Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows :--

- 15 the this Act, shall be, and they are hereby constituted a body politic and corporate, in fact and in name, under the name of "La Caisse de Bien-Corporate fissance de Tempérance, section St. Jacques," and by that name shall name and have power from time to time, and at any time hereafter, to purchase, powers. acquire, possess, hold, exchange, accept and receive for themselves and
- 20 their successors, all lands, tenements and hereditaments, and all real or immovable estate, being and situated in Lower Canada necessary for the actual use and occupation of the said corporation, not exceeding in annual value two thousand dollars, and the said property to hypothecate, sell, alienate and dispose of, and to acquire other instead thereof, for
- 25 the same purposes; and any majority whatsoever of the said corporation, for the time being, shall have full power and authority to make and establish such rules, regulations and by-laws, in no respect inconsistent with this Act, nor with the laws then in force in Lower Canada, as they may deem expedient and necessary for the interests and ad-
- 80 ministration of the affairs of the said corporation, and for the admission of members thereof; and the same to amend and repeal from time to time, in whole or in part, and also the regulations and by-laws of the said association that may be in force at the time of the passing of this Act; such majority may also execute and administer, or cause to be
- 35 executed and administered, all and every the other business and matters appertaining to the said corporation, and the government and management thereof, in so far as the same may come under their control, respect being nevertheless had to the regulations, stipulations, provisions and by-laws to be hereafter passed and established.

The rents, revenues and profits of the said corporation, shall be Applications appropriated and employed exclusively for the benefit of the members of rents, of the said corporation, and for the erection and repair of the buildings revenues &c. necessary for the purposes of the said corporation, and for the payment
